TOPIC: A CALL FOR RECONCILIATION

Oh, give ear, Shepherd of Israel, You who lead Joseph like a flock; You who are enthroned above the cherubim, shine forth! Psalms.80:1

Monday : 28th

“He has redeemed my soul in peace from the battle that was against me, For there were many against me.”

Psalm 55:18

- a) Thank God for he has been a good shepherd over Kenya.
- b) Let us thank God for Peace that has prevailed during and after the elections.
- c) Confess the sin of un-forgiveness and anger manifested so strongly all over the republic.
- d) Repent on behalf of Kenya of the sin of rebellion that is the main barrier of meaningful relationships with Jehovah and fellow man.
- e) Invite God to dissolve all ancient ethnic hostilities between various communities.
- f) Pray that God would pour afresh a spirit of forgiveness and reconciliation in the nation.
- g) Pray that Kenya as a nation will return to the Lord and take her place in Africa and the world as a worshipping and praying nation.

Tuesday : 29th

“I am the LORD, and there is no other; There is no God besides Me. I will gird you, though you have not known Me, That they may know from the rising of the sun to its setting That there is none besides Me. I am the Lord, and there is no other.” Isaiah.45:5-6

- a) Thank Him for the many blessings of liberty to preach, assemble and proclaim the Gospel.
- b) Thank God for the President, his Deputy and all the leaders including, Governors, Senators, MP’s, Women Reps. and all others that have come to serve the new Government.
- c) Lay the hearts of our leaders in His hand and ask God to guide them to do what is right and Just in their line of duty for the sake of the righteous in the land.
- d) Pray that people of Kenya will find their identity, significance and security in God and not in the fleeting things such as human deities, wealth, image and fame.
- e) Pray for the truth of God to surpass every other voices in the lives of the people of Kenya.
- f) Pray that Godly value will be established in our families, communities and in the nation.
- g) That as Jehovah God restrained Balaam from cursing the children of Israel on their way to the Promised Land, He will restrain and stop the wicked from carrying out their evil agendas and plans against the Church and the land.

Wednesday : 30th

“For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; it is He who will save us.”Isaiah.33:22

- a) Invite the good shepherd/Great King into Kenya and ask him to take hold of this nation and lead it in his paths of righteousness for His names sake.
- b) Declare that the word of the Lord will guard and influence all the three arms of the Government. That the word of God and the Holy Spirit will have greater influence here than men, media etc.
- c) Pray that God’s counsel will prevail in the ruling of the presidential case currently at the Supreme Court.
- d) Take authority in Jesus name and silence all the voices of strange shepherds. Pray that Kenyans and those living in Kenya will reject all together the strange shepherds, their ideas, doctrines and voices.
- e) That God will divinely remove any tension created by the results of the just concluded elections.
- f) Invite the Judge of the Universe this day to deal with those who have set themselves up against his people. Pray against those who fight in the name of false religion and gods. Ask God to destroy the power of evil alters raised in the country and to establish his name over the land.

- g) Pray and ask God to do something in Kenya that will cause His name to be honored and feared; and His Holy word and Servants respected.

Thursday : 31st

“My times are in your hands; deliver me from my enemies and from those who pursue me.” Psalms.31:15

- a) Confess in any way you or your family members have been involved in stoking up violence in any way.
- b) Pray and rededicate the 44 tribes of Kenya to God and the nation as a whole. Surrender the remaining months of this year to the hands of the Almighty God.
- c) Pray for the safety and prosperity of all inhabitants in Kenya.
- d) Pray and ask God to deliver the country from her enemies. Pray against the power of terrorism and the spirit of destruction.
- e) Pray for the strengthening of our army and security agents as they contend the enemies of this nation. Pray for divine power and support them daily in prayer.
- f) Pray for parents whose children are serving in the army, pray for brothers and sisters of those who are serving the country in our armed forces, the police and even the security guards who have done a great job in fighting terrorism and other manner of insecurity.
- g) Pray that the security arms of the government will be revamped, equipped and their welfare undertaken by this new government.

Friday : 01st

“Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet Before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD .And he will turn The hearts of the fathers to the children, And the hearts of the children to their fathers, Lest I come and strike the earth with a curse.” Malachi: 5-6

- a) Pray for People in Kenya to honor God in everything that they do, as their Heavenly Father.
- b) That the newly elected leaders will honor and respect the followers in all spheres of life (business, religion, politics etc)
- c) Pray for the people of Kenya that they will in turn learn to honor, respect and pray for their leaders at

all levels. **Titus.3:1**

- d) That the Heavenly Father's anointing will come upon the men in the land and turn them to be fathers to the children of Kenya.
- e) That the Holy spirit will restore healthy relationships between fathers and their children and vice versa.
- f) Pray and ask Jehovah Rapha (our healer) to supernaturally heal the people and the land of Kenya.
- g) That this healing wave/fragrance will spread to the other African nations bringing healing and order to the African continent.

Saturday : 02nd

"Hear the word of the Lord, O nations, And declare it in the isles afar off, and say, He who scattered Israel will gather him, And keep him as a shepherd does his flock."Jeremiah.31:10

- a) Bless the Lord the giver of life and protection. Pray for the people of Kenya to recognize God as the author and source of life and the only source of help.
- b) By the Blood of Jesus Christ nullify all the covenants, agreements, and token, oaths that our leaders and people of Kenya have entered into with enemies of the Lord and evil forces of Darkness.
- c) That in His mercy, God will remember the Church of Jesus Christ and gather her from where she has been scattered and keep her in His perfect love and unity.
- d) Pray that God's love will be experienced in His people in Kenya that they would be able to love one another.
- e) That God will remove wickedness from the hearts of men and women in the land.
- f) Pray for the move of the Spirit to convict people of the need to be reconciled to God and to fellow man through Jesus Christ.
- g) Pray and ask God to stretch His Mighty hand over this nation and cause His greatness to be seen in all counties.

Sunday : 03rd

“The couriers went out, hastened by the King’s command; and the decree was proclaimed in Shushan the citadel, So the king and Haman sat down to drink, but the city of Shushan was perplexed.” Esther.3:15

- a) *“Then God opened up the hollow place in Lehi, and water came out of it. When Samson drank, his strength returned and he revived. Pray and ask God to strike well in the spirit and refresh His body.*
- b) Ask God to water and cause the work of prayer done through various prayer initiatives be felt in every fiber being of the 47 counties.
- c) Pray for Father’s anointing to come upon the saints to impart boldness, divine wisdom, knowledge and counsel to counteract the company of Herod and Haman in the land.
- d) Pray that God will defend this nation by His name and will cause the angel of destruction (Violence, lawlessness, bloodshed, etc) to pass over.
- e) Give thanks for the relationships that God has given Kenya and the Nation of Israel, pray for this relationship to continue growing from strength to strength.
- f) Pray for the congregation who will take the torch of prayer after you, that God will fill them with His Spirit as they pray for the nation.
- g) Thank God for answers to our prayers.
