TOPIC: DISCIPLINED FORCES

26th June -2nd July 2017

Psalms 127:1 "If the Lord does not build the house, the work of the builders is useless; if the Lord does not protect the city, it is useless for the sentries to stand guard."

According to reports in the DN on 26th May 2017;

- May 15 Mr.Dekow Abey, the chief of Omar Jillow location in Mandera was shot dead by Alshabaab in raid at his home.
- May 16, four people die after a vehicle they were travelling in hit an explosive (IED) planted on the road in Dadaab, Garissa.
- May 17, a land surveyor killed in similar explosive in Elwak, Mandera.
- May 24, three Administrative Police officers killed when their car was blown up in the morning by an explosive planted on the road between Liboi and Kulan in Mandera.
- May 24, Later in the afternoon, five Police officers who were in a convoy escorting Mandera
 Governor Ali Roba were killed when their vehicle run over an IED at Fino.
- May 25, two Police officers killed after their vehicle ran over a landmine between Malelei and Kulan in Garissa County.

These and many other incidences involving security officers are causing a concern especially during this time of campaigns and elections due in August.

Prayer:

Monday 26th June 2017: (Discipline, Loyalty, Integrity and Patriotism.)

- ✓ Let us pray for the security of all our armed forces as they carry out the duty of protecting the nation. Pray for courage and strength..
- ✓ Let us pray that our forces that will adhere to the discipline they are taught and known all over the world of our defense forces. Pray that they will use their discipline to share intelligence.

Wednesday 28th June 2017 (Intelligence Training and advanced Ammunitions.)

✓ Our defense forces are some of the best trained in the world. We thank God for this advancement as we seek God for resources to take them even higher in intelligence gathering so that they can watch over pour nation better equipped.

✓ Pray for provision from God of partners and allies that we will share intelligence and technology to be able to cover our nation with security. Pray that all the intelligence gathered will be of value to the nation and will be useful for protection of our country.

✓ Cover in prayer all our defense personnel posted along the Somali border. They live under threat always. Pray that they will be courageous and that they will be alert to deal with any threat always

Thursday 29th June 2017: Stigma
