- Pray for job creation. Pray that many sustainable opportunities will emerge for the nation and its people. Pray that the business community will be influenced the fear of God and that they will inherit and practice godliness.
- Pray for Christians in business that we shall also find a place for reaching out to the people we shall partner with. Pray that we shall not only be after profits but after the souls so that they may be secured eternally.

Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> Oct 2017-Political and economic Partners:

Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> Oct 2017-Money idolatry

Ask God to expose evil in Jesus name. Politics of elections are over, pray that the county governments will now concentrate in improving the lives of the people who elected them.
- Pray against corruption in the civil service and in the private sector. The examples that have been set is to have a culture of quick riches. Many people want to be in certain positions to “eat” pray against this vice in Jesus name. Pray that the corrupt may be exposed.

Friday 20<sup>th</sup> Oct 2017-Mashujaa Prayers:
