PRAYER GUIDE- 23RD-29TH OCTOBER

Monday 23rd Oct. 2017: Securing the nation:

Isa 26:2-4

Open ye the gates, that the righteous nation which keepeth faith may enter in. Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee; because he trusteth in thee. Trust ye in Jehovah for ever; for in Jehovah, even Jehovah, is an everlasting rock.

The nation of Kenya is kept alive by God Himself and no one else can take credit. We have come to near collapse many times, but God keeps away the gravity of evil that the nation may remain standing. Even this week, the Lord will uphold us.

- Pray that every spiritual battle-field in the heavenlies that the nation of Kenya is being contested, the angels of God will triumph. There is a big battle going on over the soul of our nation, repent and call on God over the sins the people of Kenya and their leaders have committed against God.
- Pray that the lord will usher-in the nation of Kenya into a new season led by Him as our shepherd. Seek peace over Kenya and the favour of God because of the prayer of the saints.
- Rebuke the lie of Satan that is in the lips of many Kenyans that the church has failed the state. There are hundreds of sermons that are preached on pulpits in churches ever Sunday calling on citizens to repentance and living righteous lives. The church has kept constantly in prayer for the nation and the leaders. Refuse confusion in Jesus name and persist in prayer.
- Trust Kenya in the hands of Jehovah the everlasting rock this morning. Pray that our strength as a nation will only come from Him and that any decisions that will be reached by our leaders and other bodies like IEBC will be within the will of God over the nation.

Tuesday 24th Oct 2017: Idol Worship

2 Chro 23:16-19

And Jehoiada made a covenant between himself, and all the people, and the king, that they should be Jehovah's people. And all the people went to the house of Baal, and brake it down, and brake his altars and his images in pieces, and slew Mattan the priest of Baal before the altars. And Jehoiada appointed the officers of the house of Jehovah under the hand of the priests the Levites, whom David had distributed in the house of Jehovah, to offer the burnt-offerings of Jehovah, as it is written in the law of Moses, with rejoicing and with singing, according to the order of David. And he set the porters at the gates of the house of Jehovah, that none that was unclean in anything should enter in.

have made other gods their god and forgotten that there is only one true God. Repent the sin of idolatry.

- Citizens have forgotten God and worshipped their leaders, political parties and consulted the occult in the name of securing their leaders victory. All this has brought abomination to the land. Pray a prayer of cleansing of the land of Kenya by the precious blood of Jesus Christ.
- Driven by hatred of people outside their community, many people driven by a tribal agenda have spread rumours and lies targeting other Kenyans. Pray for peace among Kenyans; Pray that God will cause confusion in the fake news and their intended evil purpose be rebutted by a message of peace and unity.
- Pray for the judicial arm of government, that all matters placed before them regarding the coming elections will be guided by justice and truth. Pray that not judge or judicial officer will go against the oath he/she has taken to protect the sovereignty of the people of Kenya.

Wednesday 25th Oct 2017: Love among Kenyans

1 John 3:9-11;15

Whosoever is begotten of God doeth no sin, because his seed abideth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is begotten of God.

In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother. For this is the message which ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another:..... Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him.

- Tomorrow we go to the polls a divided country. Some have chosen not to vote for reasons they hold as right. Others have chosen to vote for what they feels is their democratic right. Even then, we remain brothers despite our strong political opinions. Pray that these opinions will not grow into hatred that would cause division.
- Many opinions are going to be expressed today by our leaders. Others will ask us to take very strong positions that could degenerate into violence against each other. Pray that we shall respect each other's rights and find a place in our hearts for tolerance.
- Pray for the peace keeping agents. Pray that they shall act in restrain even in the height of provocation. Pray for wisdom in handling the situation in the country. Pray for citizens to be wise when they listen to leaders and that they will distinguish hate speech and refuse to be incited against their fellow brothers.
- Pray for the IEBC that they will be impartial and act within their constitution mandate. Pray for the safety of all IEBC officers and that they will execute their duties without fear of harm. Pray for peace over the entire country.

Thursday 26th Oct 2017:Peaceful Voting

Ezekiel 36:33-36

Thus saith the Lord Jehovah: In the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will cause the cities to be inhabited, and the waste places shall be built. And the land that was desolate shall be tilled, whereas it was a desolation in the sight of all that passed by. And they shall say, This land that was desolate is become like the garden of Eden; and the waste and desolate and ruined cities are fortified and inhabited. - Pray that the vote today will translate into a restoration like God did to Israel. Pray that our land will be fruitful; the soil will be fertile to produce a good crop; pray that the industries for manufacturing will be re-opened a fresh and jobs created in the new dispensation.
- Pray for favour with the nations around us and the world at large. Pray that the world will recognize the new government and that we shall have a free and fair election throughout the republic.
- Pray that Jehovah will be the lord over this nation; some leaders have called on witches to stop the poll today; let Jehovah rein.

Friday 27th Oct 2017 –Thanksgiving:

Psalm 117

O praise the Lord, all ye nations:
