



PRAYERS FOR THE NATION

TOPIC: RESTORATION OF THE NATION

27th November to 03rd December, 2017

You will arise and have compassion on Zion (Kenya), for it is time to show favor to her; the appointed time has come. For her stones are dear to your servants; her very dust moves them to pity” (Psalm 102; 13-14)

Monday : 27th

Unless the LORD build the house, its builders labor in vain. Unless the LORD watches over the city, the watchmen stand guard in vain.” Psalm 127:1

- a) Thank God for Peace that is being witnessed in the nation.
- b) Confess the sin of un-forgiveness and anger manifested so strongly all over the republic.
- c) That God will divinely remove any tension created by the just concluded electioneering season.
- d) Pray that the LORD himself will build this house called Kenya and will watch the nation during the swearing in ceremony and thereafter.
- e) Thank God for this first family of Uhuru and Margaret and their children. Pray for their protection and good health during this ceremony and after.
- f) Pray that their family unit would be kept intact during their time in office and their unity will be a good example to other families in the nation.
- g) Pray for the deputy President elect- William Ruto and his wife who have demonstrated great humility and brokenness during this season. Pray that this family too will be kept intact and will deputize the government in a most able and humble manner.
- h) Thank God for Hon Raila Odinga, pray for continued good health and for grace to accept the Court’s verdict and join hand in building the nation.
- i) Cancel any plans of the enemy to bring confusion or to disrupt the swearing ceremony of the 5th President of Kenyan republic and pray that the prince of peace Jesus Christ will reign.

Tuesday : 28th

“For he himself is our peace, who has made the two one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility.....His purpose was to create in himself one new man out of the two thus making peace” (Eph. 2:14,15)

- a) Thank God for each and every Kenyan who lives in this Nation.
- b) Thank God for the opportunity afforded to all to exercise their democratic right and voting for the leaders of their choice.
- c) Pray that God will destroy any wall of division created by the elections and will unite the people of Kenya into one nation under God Almighty.
- d) Pray that God would give the President and His Deputy wisdom and knowledge and they will do all it takes to have an all inclusive government.
- e) Pray that Hon Raila Odinga will exercise good leadership and guide his followers in working peacefully, respecting and supporting the new government in place.
- f) Pray that the newly elected leaders be they governors, senators, MPs or others will all preach one message of peace, love and unity.
- g) Pray that the media and the socio media will be held captive to peace and unity.
- h) Pray for the Church that their member will obey the command to pray for the peace of the nation, for if it prospers, they too will prosper (Jer. 29:7)

Wednesday : 29th

“I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten- the great locust and the young locust, the other locusts and the locust swarm- my great army that I sent among you. You will have plenty to eat, until you are full, and you will praise the name of the LORD your God who has worked wonders for you; never again will my people be ashamed”. (Joel 2:25-26)

- a) Thank God for the promises He Has made concerning Kenya, and also prophetic role of the Nation in this end time.
- b) That God will restore the reputation of the Church and Nation and heal their images respectively.
- c) Ask the LORD to remember Kenya and show her favor in accordance with the promise of Joel 2.
- d) Pray that a “Joseph” will arise who will transform the agricultural sector making Kenya net exporter not only of agricultural produce but in value addition as well.
- e) Pray that he (God) will rebuke the devourer of crops and the nation’s harvest will be plenty for domestic consumption and for export.
- f) God will divinely bring a change in weather patterns of our pastoral land; sufficient rainfall to give

enough pastures for immediate consumption and fodder for dry season.

- g) Pray that policies that have favored foreigners with the profits of our produce will be reviewed so that Kenyans will benefit from their labors.
- h) Pray also that farm workers and other casual laborers in this country will be well remunerated- not only to feed their families but to save for future.

Thursday : 30th

“Your people will rebuild the ancient ruins and will raise up age –old foundations. You will be called Repairer of Broken Walls. Restorer of Streets with Dwellings” (Isa. 58:12)

- a) Confess in any way you or your family members have been involved in firing up violence.
- b) Pray for the safety and prosperity of all inhabitants in Kenya
- c) Thank God for the devolution of resources to the county level, and therefore availability of resources that could be used to improve the habitats of many of these Kenyan.
- d) Pray that governors will prioritize housing in the cities and towns within their counties and will partner with the private sector to improve on the housing for the city dwellers.
- e) Pray that these governors will receive divine strategies to improve on the welfare of the city dwellers.
- f) *In many of the cities and towns, the councils have failed in dealing with garbage management and collection. Pray for a lasting solution for this problem.*
- g) *In many cities in the Western Hemisphere, Garbage is an energy resource. Sweden imports garbage from Norway and they use the garbage to run the water heating system and other energy needs. Pray that the cities of Kenya adopt good management of waste.*
- h) Pray that the plans for the management of vehicle jams in cities like Mombasa, Nairobi, Nakuru, Eldoret and Kisumu will be followed to the letter. Pray that the county governments will look to this problem that wastes human resources, time and finances.
- i) Pray for all the arms of government mandated with security, that they will be well resourced and provide security to city dwellers.
- j) Pray for transformation of cities of this nation.

Friday : 01st

“Down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations.”Rev.22:2

- a) Praise God for bringing us into a new month.
- b) Praise God for His faithfulness and protection over Kenya in the month of November 2017.
- c) Declare that the gates of your life, family and nation will be open continually this new month to receive blessings (Isaiah.60:11)
- d) Command the north, south, east and west gates of Kenya to open for the King of glory to come in. Ps.24
- e) That the gates of your life, city and nation will be shut to uncleanness, witchcraft, drugs, perversion, violence, bloodshed and any manner of wickedness throughout this month of December.
- f) Pray for the gateway cities in our nation to be gateways of righteousness and not iniquity this month.
- g) Pray that the things God wants to birth in this nation and in your life this month shall be birthed. That any agenda of the enemy and his agents to disappoint, destroy, frustrate will not succeed.
- h) Pray and ask God to initiate a healing wave that will spread to the other African nations bringing healing and order to the African continent.

Saturday : 02nd

“Hear the word of the Lord, O nations, And declare it in the isles afar off, and say, He who scattered Israel will gather him, And keep him as a shepherd does his flock.”Jeremiah.31:10

- a) Bless the Lord the giver of life and protection. Pray for the people of Kenya to recognize God as the author and source of life and the only source of help.
- b) By the Blood of Jesus Christ nullify all the covenants, agreements, and token, oaths that our leaders and people of Kenya have entered into with enemies of the Lord and evil forces of Darkness.
- c) That in His mercy, God will remember the Church of Jesus Christ and gather her from where she has been scattered and keep her in His perfect love and unity.
- d) Pray that God’s love will be experienced in His people in Kenya that they would be able to love one another.

- e) That God will remove wickedness from the hearts of men and women in the land.
- f) Pray for the move of the Spirit to convict people of the need to be reconciled to God and to fellow man through Jesus Christ.
- g) Pray and ask God to stretch His Mighty hand over this nation and cause His greatness to be seen in all counties.

Sunday : 03rd

“I have posted watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they will never be silent day or night. You who call on the LORD, give yourselves no rest and give him no rest till he establishes Jerusalem and makes her the praise of the earth (Isa. 62:6-7)

- a) Thank God because it is he who raised intercession for our nation to accomplish his purposes.
- b) Thank him for raising many in the nation who will not rest until they see the transformation of Kenya.
- c) Pray that God will renew the energies and the resolve of the Christians who will continue to keep watch over the nation.
- d) Pray that in every county, God would post watchmen who will pray day and night until they see development happening in these counties.
- e) Pray for total transformation of the nation; spiritual, economic, and social and culture.
- f) Pray for a renewal of the vision of Christian Prayer Network; pray that county secretariat will be raised who will spearhead prayers in line with the development agenda of the counties.
