Monday 30th Oct. 2017: Thanksgiving for Elections

“Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God beside you, who acts on behalf of those who wait for him” (Isa. 64:4)

Tues. 31st Oct.: Healing for a divided nation

- Mention communities by name and declare that praise will come out of every one of them.
- Pray that those leaders that promote negative ethnicity will no longer be tolerated and their influence will die out while those serving God's purposes will be elevated.
- Confess your own sin and that of your congregation and others in the body of Christ for harboring negative biases against other communities. Pray that God will forgive us and heal our land. (1 John 1:9)

Thursday 2nd Nov. 2017: Church of Jesus Christ in Kenya

Friday Nov. 3rd, 2017: Judiciary

- Every Kenyan now knows how powerful the judges are and we thank God for the established independence of the Judiciary. This independence can be abused if judges are corrupt and accept bribes.
- Pray for the Judiciary in this season, as judges dispense justice in issues of leadership of the nation.
- Thank God for the judges and lawyers who are God fearing and do not accept bribes but dispense justice without fear or favor.
- Pray that corrupt and inept judges will be exposed and taken out of the justice system, so true justice can be rendered in our courts.
- Pray for God’s wisdom for the Supreme Court as it deals with the cases that will be presented concerning the presidency of this nation. Pray that they will uphold, God’s choices on the leadership of the nation.
- Pray for the office of the Prosecutor, where many times even very clear cases are thrown out, because of inadequate investigations or corruption that has led to justice being denied and culprits being set free
- Ask God to raise men and women who will work on the proposed reforms that will see even the common person receive justice in the Kenyan courts.

Saturday Nov. 4th 2017: Our families shall not keep quiet

“..And give him no rest until He establishes Jerusalem and makes it a praise in the earth, Isaiah 62:7”

PRAY that;

- Our families shall keep watch and pray for this country- Let all with one accord in common bond united, Build this our nation together
- We shall on our knees fight for our sisters, brothers, mothers, fathers, in-laws; etc(Nehemiah 4:14)
- Families to build altars and declare their dependence on God and God alone, (Joshua 24:15)

- Let each family have its needs met by God who supplies them without measure, such that no family shall feel out of place especially this time when prices of consumer goods are sky rocketing.

Sunday 5th Nov. 2017: Godly Leadership in Place

- Pray that the President will not enter into unholy alliances that will derail God’s purposes over the nation of Kenya.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will work in the elected leaders and they will call and turn to God bringing righteous leadership in the land.
- Bring down in the name of Jesus the spirit of greed in the leaders of the nation, that has perpetuated corrupt practices
- Cancel in the name of Jesus idol worship and also those now going back to traditional ways of worship, ie. Facing Mt. Kenya. It is like a dog going back to its vomit. Denounce these practices and also those practicing witchcraft.
- Pray that as the President chooses his cabinet only those that will not hinder the move of God in the land will be chosen. That the new cabinet will bring a breath of fresh air, not representing tribal but national aspirations.
