Monday 11th : THANKSGIVING

- c) Him alone deserves the Praise for holding the nation together despite the difficult moments we have gone through.
- d) Thank God for giving us a government led by President Uhuru and his deputy William Ruto.
- e) Thank God for giving us all the 47 governors and their deputies
- f) Thank God for the many members of parliament at the national level and the county levels.
- g) Praise God who alone has allowed all the leaders at all levels including the senate.
- h) Thank God for all the people who exercised their democratic right and voted for the leaders of their choice.



Tuesday 12th Dec.: THANKSGIVING FOR JAMHURI DAY

As Kenyans celebrate the Jamhuri day, there is joy and pain in equal measure. There is a section of the Kenyan Population that is feeling left out and neglected and their leaders have taken to creating what they consider a peoples assemblies. - b) Acknowledge that leaders are chosen by God though you may not personally like them, you need to walk in obedience and submit to the elected leadership
- c) Confess the sin of Christians and their leaders who have out of fear have not openly condemned this attempt at swearing in another not constitutionally elected.
- d) Confess the sins of the leaders of the last government and subsequent governments who may have contributed greatly to the feeling non inclusivity.
- e) Confess the sin of rebellion which is very great in the eyes of God, when people publicly and in private life reject the leaders God has placed in the land. (Rom. 13)
- f) Pray for a breakthrough in the discussions of inclusivity that have been initiated and pray that Hon. Raila Odinga and his followers will accept the current President and work with him for the sake of unity.
- g) Pray that as we celebrate this Jamhuri, the LORD will unite and heal our divisions
- h) Ask God like David prayed, “to hide his face from our sins and to blot out our iniquities. To create in us a pure heart and to renew a steadfast spirit within us (Psa. 51:9-10)

Wednesday 13th Dec. Righteous Leadership for Kenya



“See a king will reign in righteousness and rulers will rule with justice. Each one will be like a shelter from the wind and a refuge from the storm, like streams of water in the desert and the shadow of a great rock in a thirsty land” (Isa. 32:1-2)

- a) Thank God who has in these last days given us his son Jesus Christ, who by his death has reclaimed the Authority from the enemy and delegated it to his sons and daughters
- b) Thank God for President Uhuru Kenyatta and the humility he showed as he asked Kenyans to pray the Lord’s Prayer during his inauguration.
- c) Pray that the Lord’s Spirit will rest on him and fully take control of his life making him to rule the nation as unto the LORD
- d) Pray that the Holy Spirit will brood over his heart and bring conviction. As you pray believe and allow this to happen. The power of a righteous person is powerful and effective James 5:15
- e) Thank God for the Deputy President William Ruto and thank God too for his wife Rachel and the role she has played in praying for him and for the nation.
- f) Pray that the DP will not be consumed by politics of 2022 but will allow God to work through him to bring the nation under God.
- g) Pray that a Spirit of truth and integrity will rest over DP’s life and he will turn a new leaf, that will see him renounce corruption and blind ambition

Thursday 14th Dec: New Cabinet

“Each one will be like a shelter from the wind and a refuge from the storm. Like streams of water in the desert and the shadow of a great rock in a parched land” Isa. 32:2

- a) Pray that the President and his deputy will be led of God as they choose the new Cabinet who will lead the various ministries
- b) Pray that those men and women of integrity will pass through the vetting and will take charge of the various duties assigned
- c) Pray the choosing of cabinet ministers will be done in an inclusive way that will bring healing of the nation.
- d) Pray that each one who will be chosen, will have such grace to lead that they will bring about the needed reforms in most sectors.



- e) Pray that God will give each of the chosen leaders such wisdom to deal with the challenges on the ground and many will emulate the work done by the current minister for education, Dr. Matiangi.
- f) Pray that duty to the public will be uppermost and indeed they will be like a shelter from the storm for those they work with and serve.

Friday 15th Dec.: Judiciary

“Justice will rule in the wilderness and righteousness in the fertile field. And this righteousness will bring peace. Yes, it will bring quietness and confidence forever” Isa. 32:16-17

- a) Thank God for the Judiciary in this country. Mention the chief Justice, David Maraga and thank God for he seems to be a god fearing judge and has withstood pressure asserting the independence of the Supreme Court.
- b) Pray that God will move in a mighty way among the judiciary and true reforms will be undertaken purging corruption in the courts of justice.
- c) Pray that partisan and corrupt judicial officers and judges will be shown the door and will no longer become stumbling blocks to dispensation of justice.
- d) Pray that in this new dispensation, the allure of money will lose its luster and justice will be dispensed as various judges look for lasting legacy
- e) Pray that the Holy Spirit through the Christian Judicial officers, will be allowed to move freely breaking strongholds and upholding justice in the land.
- f) Pray for strengthening of the various Christian fellowships in various judicial sectors so the name of God will be lifted high and fear of God will pervade.
- g) Pray that the weakest and feeblest of Kenyans will get justice in this land and the confidence in the judiciary will be restored.
- h) Pray that the judiciary will receive the needed resources, to deal with the great backlog of cases due to the electoral cases this year.

Saturday 16th Dec. : Open Ye the Gates that the King of Glory May Come in
