Monday 6th Nov.: Affirm God's sovereignty in leadership of nations

"...Then I praised the Most High; I honored and glorified him who lives forever. His dominion is an eternal dominion; his kingdom endures from generation to generation..... All the peoples of the earth are regarded as nothing. He does as he pleases with the powers of heaven and the peoples of the earth. No one can hold back his hand or say to him: What have you done?" (Dan. 4:34b-35).

- a) Praise the LORD and honor him as the LORD over the whole universe and creator of all
- b) Acknowledge him over the affairs and peoples of Kenya
- c) He alone is worthy of our worship and no other god should receive our worship.
- d) Praise him for sending his son Jesus to die on the cross thereby ushering God's reign on earth taking the authority from Satan who held the authority after man's sin.
- e) Praise Jesus whose Kingdom will never end and declare that the government of Kenya will be on his shoulders.
- f) Declare Jesus as the King of Kings and ruler of the kings of the earth (Rev. 1:5)
- g) Praise him who alone has determined the ruler who will rule Kenya after this period we are in.
- h) Declare that the peoples of Kenya from the least to the greatest, the youngest to the oldest, the poorest to the rich, all Kenya will worship the King.

Tuesday 7th Nov.: Confessing the sin of Idolatry- worship of other gods in the Church

And he said to me, "Go in and see the wicked and detestable things they are doing here. So I went in and looked, and I saw sprawled all over the walls all kinds of things and unclean animals and all the idols of Israel Each had a sensor in his hand and a fragrant cloud of incense was rising.....and I saw women sitting there mourning the god Tammuz..... between the portico and the alter were about 25 men. With their backs towards the temple of the LORD and their faces towards east, they were bowing down to the sun in the east" (Ezek. 8:9-11,14-16)

- a) Confess the sin of idolatry and witchcraft that is even found within the churches. Some pastors, eager to get members, visit the witches and are operating under a different anointing. Members are not different and when faced with real difficulties will visit the



witch doctors. The churches are defiled and the Spirit of God will not move freely or work when such evil things are tolerated.

- b) As Christians have been praying for the nation, and some have also taken sides and focused on the politicians who in reality are not their friends or enemies. Confess the sin of ignorance on the devil's tactics and ask God to open your eyes to allow you to know how you ought to be praying.
- c) Confess and renounce the sin of idolatry in the church and plead the blood of Jesus over the entire church
- d) Thank Him who has promised to forgive if we confess our sins. 1 John 1:9
- e) Ask God like David prayed, "to hide his face from our sins and to blot out our iniquities. To create in us a pure heart and to renew a steadfast spirit within us (Psa. 51:9-10)

Wednesday 8th Nov. Violence in the land

He said to me, "Have you seen this, son of man? It is a trivial matter for the people of Judah to do the detestable things they are doing here? Must they also fill the land with violence and continually arouse my anger?...." (Ezek. 8:17)

- a) Confess the sin of violence that has become so rampant especially during this electioneering period. In the name of peaceful protests, lives, especially of poor people following blindly as the leaders get into big vehicle and speed off.
- b) Every life matters, whether it is of protestor or a policeman and remember when they die before knowing God, they are lost for good.
- c) Pray that the church will have a heart of love and pray against violence and also preach the gospel of peace.
- d) We have been called to do spiritual warfare and loose these leaders from the bondage of the evil one.
- e) Pray that the powers operating in some of the politicians be brought down in the name of Jesus and that they would come to the knowledge of God.
- f) Call these politicians by name in prayer and ask the HOLY Spirit to brood over their hearts and bring conviction. The power of a righteous person is powerful and effective James 5:15
- g) Pray that the Spirit of God would brood over the nation uproot from our midst the spirits of violence. Such phrases as Tibim and Tialala or even the Mungiki all are extolling violence. In the name of Jesus declare that these voices would be silenced and peace to reign in Kenya.
- h) Thank and Praise the LORD who has promised to heal our land,



9th Nov. 2017: Strikes and Civil Disobedience

As we speak, the health sector in Kenya had been paralyzed because of nurses strike and some universities are closed until further notice because the students went on strike. The industrial actions this year have become so punitive to the public, and at a time, when we don't have a fully functioning presidency and the government does not have money because of prolonged drought and prolonged electioneering. Politicians are now calling for further strikes and this will cripple the economy further and yet other legal options are available to them. It is time to call public servants and politicians to order. Kenyans are dying because of ignorance.

“Let everyone be subject to the governing authorities for there is no authority except that which God has established. For rulers hold no terror for those who do right but for those who do wrong..... Therefore, it is necessary to submit to the authorities, not only because of possible punishment but also as a matter of conscience” (Rom. 13:1-5)

- a) Thank God that nurses are back to work but confess the sin that public servants are committing by continuing to withhold their services especially those in the health sector. Confess too for those in authority who are not taking this issue seriously and yet lives are getting lost.
- b) Declare in the name of Jesus that all rebellion be broken in the name of Jesus.
- c) Pray that God using those in authority will raise men and women who will mediate and come up with lasting solutions in all these sectors.
- d) Pray that those deals that are done in secret, to perpetuate the culture of impunity will be exposed and those found culpable will be held to account.
- e) There are those in the government ministry and the outgoing governors who squandered the money meant for health sector. Pray that they will be held accountable and made to pay.
- f) Pray that no further siege will be called to paralyze the health sector, and anyother strikes planned would be broken in Jesus name.
- g) Declare that evil forces, powers and strategies against Kenya will suddenly fall and be broken



Friday 10th Nov. 2017: Political solution

The LORD said to me, “Son of man, these are the men who are plotting evil and giving wicked advice in the city……. Therefore prophesy against them; prophesy son of man” Now as I was prophesying, Pelatiah son of Benaiah died. Then I fell face down and cried in a loud voice. Alas Sovereign LORD! Will you completely destroy the remnant of Israel? (Ezek. 11:2,13)

- a) Confess your sins and ask the Holy Spirit to fill you as you take time to pray for the nation.
- b) Allow the Spirit to lead you in your utterances as you deal with the wicked people who are giving wrong advice to our political leaders.
- c) As seen in the passage above, there are some that God may choose to destroy but remember it is never God’s first choice that any should perish but that they would repent and come to the knowledge of God.
- d) Pray that the security operators in the land from the highest ranking, the commander in chief of the armed forces to the lowest ranking officers will be given such wisdom and knowledge that they would expose and deal with any threat to the national cohesion and security.
- e) Pray especially against the media houses, which are being used by politicians to drive a certain narrative that is not good for this country.
- f) Break in the name of Jesus, walls of division that have been erected by politicians to keep communities apart and hence be able manipulate and do violent actions against each other.

Saturday 11th Nov. 2017: Open Ye the Gates that the King of Glory May Come in

“Lift up your heads, you gates; be lifted up, you ancient doors that the King of glory may come in. Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle” (Psalm 24:7-8)

Having dealt with the alters, wickedness, rebellion and evil schemes, It is now time to invite the LORD to take his position inside the nation and bring about the desired and awaited revival.

- a) Thank God who has promised healing of the nation through the covenant blood of Jesus Christ.
- b) Invite the LORD to take his position as the only God over Kenya.
- c) Pray that the church in Kenya will be healed, and united and will honor God by bringing men and women to the faith in Christ. Pray that winning souls for God will be the preoccupation of every believer.
- d) Pray that the leadership of this nation will submit to God and be led of him.



- e) Pray that the arms of Government mandated to make laws will only make laws and amend the constitution to cater for the leadership gaps in the current constitution.
- f) Pray that Leaders of Integrity will arise who will not compromise but lead by example emulating the servant leadership of Jesus.
- g) Pray that God who is the author of marriages, will restore families in Kenya
- h) Pray that the Youth and children will turn to God in big numbers and they will find spiritual nurture.
- i) Pray that every institution will be transformed to serve the mandate for which it was created.
- j) Invite the HOLY Spirit of the Living God to hover and brood over the nation bringing revival.

Sunday 12th Nov. , 2017 Nation under God

“Although the Lord gives you the bread of adversity and water of affliction, your teachers will be hidden no more; with your own eyes, you will see them. Whether you turn to the right of to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you saying, this is the way; walk in it. Then you will desecrate your idols overlaid with silver and your images covered with gold; you will throw them away like a menstrual cloth and say to them, Away with you.” (Isa. 301: 21-22)

- a) Thank God for keeping this nation together. Pray for the canopy of His grace and presence upon the church and the land.
- b) Pray and ask God to break every yoke of idolatry, tribalism, immorality, false religion, poverty, new age, corruption etc over the people in this land.
- c) Dedicate the people, resources and the land of Kenya to the Lord God Almighty.
- d) Pray and ask God to water this land with His fear and the knowledge of His will. Ask Him to tender and nurture this land, shepherd people to His plans and purposes.
- e) Thank God who has raised prayer over the land and pray for all prayer movements focusing on Kenya. Pray that the prayer momentum will be sustained all through this period and until Kenya becomes a praise on the earth.
