- The word of the Lord is clear that if anyone turns a deaf ear to the law, even their prayers are detestable (Prov.28:9). Confess this sin among Kenyans who break the law with impunity.
- Ask the LORD to bring down all those leaders who use corrupt means to get to leadership and who engage in corruption. This deprives the poor of their rights.
- Pray for corrupt deals in all sectors in this country to be exposed and prosecuted.
- Pray that men and women given the mandate to fight corruption will be steadfast and do the work as unto the LORD

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 25TH 2018: CALL TO ACCOUNT

“Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away. Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgement, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous. For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the wicked will perish” Psa. 1:5-6

- Pray for political will to curb the corruption in the various government ministries
- Pray also for public anger and outrage at the way high profile cases are being handled.
- For every one of these scandals, someone is being oppressed and justice is being trodden underfoot. Bribes are involved and sin is perpetuated. Pray that in this season things , will take a different turn and those involved will be brought to face trial and will be prosecuted.
- Pray for justice in each and every sector. Pray that justice will not be on sale to the highest bidder.
- Pray for the common person who has to pay extra for every commodity to accommodate the shortfall in taxes as the wealthy evade paying taxes.
- Ask that the LORD, who rules in justice and righteousness, to reign in the midst of his enemies
- Pray that leaders of integrity and the Christians in each of these sectors will make a difference and point the way for those who do not know the Lord.

THURSDAY, APRIL 26, 2018: PRESIDENCY AND CORRUPTION

“No one who practices deceit will dwell in my house; no one who speaks falsely will stand in my presence. Every morning I will put to silence all the wicked in the land; I will cut off every evil doer from the city of the LORD” (Psa. 101:7-8)

David who was anointed of God to rule his people Israel wrote this Psalm. He understood the foundations of prosperous nation.

- Pray that God would have mercy on this nation give the President a righteous indignation (holy anger) against corruption.
- Pray for a special anointing on him and as he looks for a legacy, that fighting corruption be a major agenda.
- Pray that Kenyans will be so fed up with the corruption in this country that no amount of bribery will work.

- Pray that leaders who have been involved in scandals of economic nature and other political misdemeanours will be brought to account and their dynasties will crumble.
- Pray for a Davidic anointing on the president and he will go out of his way to weed out corrupt officers among his associates and even family members.
- Pray for the leadership of the Anti Corruption Agency to go full throttle and prosecute those in involved in scandals,
- Pray that the case involving evading taxes worth Sh.2.5 will be dealt with expeditiously and culprit made to account

FRIDAY, APRIL 27, 2018: THE MOUNTAIN OF CORRUPTION TO COME DOWN

- When you meet to pray over this item, hold hands and agree and claim the promise in Matt. 18:18-19 *“ I tell you the truth, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. Again, I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven”*
- Uproot this tree that has stood throughout the over 50 years of Independence. Let the roots also come out in the name of Jesus
- Declare that Kenya will be a corruption free country and integrity will win.

SATURDAY, APRIL 28TH: FEAR OF GOD IN THE LAND
