



CHURCH IN MURANG'A

JULY 16-22 nd 2018

On the 8th of July, the first Church in Murang'a to take the torch and to pray 24/7 took the mantle and began the journey of reclaiming Muranga for Jesus once again. The once vibrant church in Murang'a is under threat in the face of various challenges. One notable factor is that now more and more people are turning back to the ancestral way of worship. Let us pray that the church will stand in unity devoid of denominational barriers and in obedience be the light that will chase away the darkness.

MONDAY, July 16th, 2018: THE CHURCH IN MURANG'A

“Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest and repent. Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me” (Rev. 3:19-20)

1. Thank God and Praise his name, for he has formed a people in this county who bear his name, the church of Jesus Christ.
2. The state of the county is an indictment on the church in general, pray that God will bring great conviction upon all the believers, and particularly in Murang'a that we will confess and repent and allow Jesus cleanse and purify us.
3. Confess on behalf of the Christians, the divisions between one denomination and another and between the so called Mainstream churches and Pentecostals.
4. Pray that there would be opportunity for Christians to confess their hurts and the willingness to forgive one another so their prayers would be heard.
5. Pray for perfect unity of mind and thought for all the Christians and that love will overlook all past offenses as the church participates in unbroken prayer chain

TUESDAY JULY 17TH 2018: FAITH OF THE BELIEVERS IN MURANG'A

“Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you. For you granted him authority over all the peoples that he might give eternal life to all those you have given him. Now this is eternal life that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ who you have sent”

1. Praise God and honour him for the gift of his son Jesus Christ.
2. Declare the authority of Jesus over all the people of Murang'a.
3. There are many people in Murang'a who do not yet know God but are marked for salvation. Pray that they would heed the voice and yield to Jesus.
4. Call them forth in the name of Jesus and pray that the Holy Spirit would bring conviction on them.
5. Pray that the light of the gospel would once more shine in Murang'a
6. Pray that the faith of the believers would be strengthened and that they would go out in the power of the Holy Spirit and declare God's kingdom.

WEDNESDAY 18th July: GLORY IN THE CHURCH IN MURANG'A

I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given, for they are yours. And glory has come to me through them. ... Protect them by the power of your name, the name you gave me, so they may be one as we are one” John 17:9-11

1. Thank God for all the believers in the county of Murang'a. Thank him that he has given them his words and they have known Jesus as their saviour
2. Pray that God would cover them with his glory, so they can shine in a dark world
3. Pray that God would pour afresh his Spirit and the Spirit of truth challenging those other spirits that are now being worshipped.
4. Pray that the church in Murang'a, will speak up in one voice and renounce any other worship other than the worship of Christ in this country
5. Pray that as Churches take the torch and pray 24/7, God's glory would shine forth and wicked strongholds and altars will be broken.

6. Pray that God would protect the church by the power of the name of Jesus.

THURSDAY, JULY 19, 2018: WORD OF TRUTH

“Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified”

John 17:17-19

The reason, so many are being swayed by the various voices is that they do not read the bible for themselves. When faced with new teachings, they have no basis for evaluating and are easily swayed.

1. Thank God for the availability of the Bible in Murang’a and in this country in General. Many have the Bible even on their phones.
2. Thank God and Praise his name for the freedom that we enjoy to read the word and to proclaim it
3. Pray that God would put a new hunger for God’s word to both believers and non believers in this county.
4. Pray that the Pastors and other church leaders would once again, read and teach God’s word from the various pulpits in Murang’a
5. Pray that the word would be spoken with power and many would listen and like the Bereans they would confirm the word by reading their Bibles for themselves.
6. Pray that a new awakening, would be stirred and believers would be keen to follow and obey the truth. This would set them apart and show them to be true disciples. John 8:31-32
7. Pray that God would raise up men and women of influence who will speak up for the truth and challenge the falsehood.

FRIDAY JULY 20TH 2018: WALK OF OBEDIENCE

“Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my father, and I too will love them and show myself to them.” (John 14:21)

1. Personally, undertake and commit to walk in the purity and truth of the Word of God in all that you will say and do, and be a shining example of righteousness, justice, love, selflessness and peace by the power of Christ.
2. Plead that the precious blood of Jesus our Redeemer will wash the Christians in Murang'a from the ancestral foundation and redeem them from any false worship.
3. Proclaim that henceforth Murang'a Christians will love Righteousness and justice and hate wickedness and all forms of evil.
4. Proclaim that by the spirit of God, an army of kingdom transformers will arise and displace all ancestral altars as well as lay new foundations for the Murang'a people.
5. Pray that a new crop of believers will arise and confront those so-called elders who are even misleading the young ones.
6. Pray for Courage and boldness as these ancestral altars are being confronted.

SATURDAY JULY 21: JUDGEMENT AGAINST FALSE RELIGION IN MURANG'A

"I know your deeds. See I have placed before you an open door, that no one can shut. I know you have little strength, yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name. I will make those of the synagogue of Satan, who claim to be Jews though they are not but are liars- I will make them come and fall down at your feet and acknowledge that I have loved you" Rev. 3:8-9

The church in Murang'a can be described by the testimony of Jesus to the Church in Laodicea. Little strength but have kept the faith.

1. Thank God for the church in Murang'a, all those who believe in the name of Jesus and his accomplished atonement through his blood that was shed on the cross of Calvary
2. Thank God who is able to save completely those who come to him because Jesus lives to intercede for them. Heb. 7:25
3. Declare that Jesus is the only true Mediator, his blood is able to cleanse completely.
4. Declare that any other form of worship in Murang'a is idolatry and has no positive effect but only defiles

5. In the name of Jesus Christ, the name above all names, declare that the ancestral “Mukurwe wa Nyagathanga” and all other altars is a spiritual illegality in light of full revelation in Jesus Christ. Speak judgement on these forms of worship and sacrifices and call forth all those practicing to denounce them.
6. Declare that all those perpetuating these altars, will fall down at the feet of the church and declare only Jesus is worthy of worship.
7. Call forth a new priesthood which is Christ Centred over the communities that resides in Murang’a
8. Pray that God would show mercy and not judgement over Murang’a and his name will be greatly feared.

SUNDAY JULY 22: OPEN DOORS FOR THE TORCH IN ALL DENOMINATIONS

“These are the words of him who is holy and true, who holds the key of David. What he opens no one can shut, and what he shuts no one can open” Rev. 3:7

1. Thank God and Praise him for this door for raising unbroken prayer chain in Murang’a
2. Thank God for the leadership of the various Pastors Fellowships who have embraced the vision and opened themselves to be champions of this initiative in Murang’a.
3. Declare that Jesus is Lord over this initiative and since he opened this door, then it will not be shut but remain open until every congregation in Murang’a is counted,
4. Pray that the leadership of the PCEA, ACK, AIC, ABC and other denominations will all come on board and be counted.
5. Pray for great favour, as we approach various Pastors that there will be great commitment and response to this initiative.
6. Pray for a prayer revival in every congregation that participates in this initiative.
7. Pray also that God would strengthen every church that participates and great love and unity will be experienced as the torch is moving from one church to another.
8. Pray that God would also bless the churches, so they can give towards this work, and many other counties may benefit as well.
